### XIXth INTER-UNIVERSITY WORKSHOP ON PHILOSOPHY AND COGNITIVE SCIENCE

Zaragoza, May 27nd – 29th 2009

**Ernest Sosa**

(Rutgers University)

The XIXth edition of the Inter-University Workshop on Philosophy and Cognitive Science will be held in Zaragoza, organized by the Department of Philosophy of the University of Zaragoza. The invited speaker will be Ernest Sosa, Professor of Philosophy at Rutgers University. In recent years Interuniversity Workshop invited speakers have been A. Clark, M. Davies, D. Dennett, J. Fodor, F. Dretske, R. Millikan, T. Burge, J. Searle, J. Kim, C. Peacocke, F. Recanati, B. Stroud, J. McDowell, N. Block, and P. Carruthers.

Ernest Sosa is Board of Governors Professor of Philosophy at Rutgers University. He is the author of over 200 articles and books, including *Knowledge in Perspective* (1991), *Epistemic Justification* (co-authored with Laurence Bonjour, 2003), *A Virtue Epistemology* (2007), and *Reflective Knowledge* (2009). A book devoted to his work, *Ernest Sosa and His Critics*, was published in 2004. Ernest Sosa edited the book series *Cambridge Studies in Philosophy* (from 1992 to 2003). He has edited the journals *Nous* (since 1999) and *Philosophy and Phenomenological Research* (since 1983). He has received numerous distinctions. He was elected President of the *American Philosophical Association* (Eastern Division, 2004), and to the *American Academy of Arts and Sciences* in 2001. He was also elected by the Oxford Philosophy Faculty to give the John Locke lectures in 2005, and will give the Carus Lectures to the American Philosophical Association in 2010. His published or forthcoming work takes up a broad range of issues in epistemology, such as foundationalism/coherentism, internalism/externalism, reliabilism, contextualism, skepticism, the Pyrrhonian problematic and the problem of easy knowledge, epistemic normativity, intuitions and their place in philosophy, epistemic agency, epistemic virtue or competence, the epistemology of disagreement, testimony and social epistemology, the nature of knowledge, and the value of knowledge.
